Survey Report about Young Unemployed

The author gives a thorough analysis of the social background and sociological implications of a new mass phenomenon: the unemployment of the young. The study is based on a sociological research in the less-developed region of the country. It emphasizes not only the difficulties of those being unemployed, but the responsibility of the Hungarian school-system which reproduces the bad starting positions of young school leavers in the labour market. The author makes distinctions between poverty and unemployment which two categories often overlap, but especially in case of young unemployed should be distinguished.
